

Trailer Sanitation Protocol for _____ (farm name)

1. After delivering a load of animals the truck trailer will be brought to _____ location for washing and cleaning.
2. Bedding and manure will be disposed of at the truck wash area in dedicated disposal areas.
3. The truck trailer will be pressure washed with a detergent and water to remove all organic debris and then disinfected with an appropriate disinfectant, following manufacturer recommendations. The disinfectant will be allowed to stay in contact for at least 15 minutes (Virkon, bleach) and then will be washed off. It is important to wash off the disinfectant because it will lead to corrosion of the body of the trailer.
4. As we ship _____ (number) times per _____ week / month , the clean truck trailer will be stored and allowed to dry in a / at _____ away from the farm at a site where no animals are housed.

Driver Biosecurity Protocols

1. The driver will be wearing clean boots and coveralls upon leaving the farm.
2. Disposable boot covers and coveralls will be used when un-loading the animals.
3. Disposable boot covers and coveralls will be removed after unloading the animals, put in a plastic garbage bag, and disposed of at the truck wash location.
